#### Who Is Springpoint?

Springpoint is a national nonprofit organization with deep expertise in building the capacity of leaders and communities to design innovative high schools. Over the last decade, we have coached over 100 schools in their innovation efforts and supported the design and launch of more than a dozen student-centered high schools in New England, as well as 25 additional schools across the nation. We work in close partnership with school leaders to elevate their instructional expertise to transform the student learning experience.

# What is the Transformative Leaders of Massachusetts (TLM) Fellowship?

The traditional approach to high school has historically prioritized the needs of privileged students over all other students. To transform this reality, we need to do high school differently. These transformative schools require transformative leaders. And transformative leaders require a new kind of preparation. In partnership with the Barr Foundation, Springpoint will launch the Transformative Leaders of Massachusetts Fellowship, welcoming the inaugural cohort in the summer of 2022. As a TLM Fellow, educators will participate in a two-year school design and leadership program that will build their leadership capacity and instructional expertise so that they can become innovative leaders and change agents in their schools and communities. Fellows will be supported in leveraging their strengths, building a community of thought partners, and preparing for the next step of their personal leadership pathway.



## Fellows will engage in powerful learning experiences focused on providing:

A deep focus on instructional and student-centered leadership in service of leading for equity and transformation

- Personalized pathways for fellows to design their individual leadership journey
- Hands-on learning through apprenticeship that leverages on-the-job learning in their current school, as well as visits to innovative high schools across the country
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  - A diverse, intimate learning cohort of fellows that provides fellowship and thought partnership
  - Layered support structures that include deep individual coaching, concrete mentorship, and connections with innovative educators across Massachusetts

- Earn a stipend of \$20,000 over two years (in addition to your current salary)
- Gain support in obtaining Massachusetts school leader licensure through the DESE alternative certification apprenticeship pathway
- Learn from a dedicated mentor at current school AND an experienced, knowledgeable Springpoint coach
- Engage with a small, diverse cohort of aspiring school leaders and expand your professional network
- Maintain a flexible class schedule (weekends, evenings, and school release days) that will complement and enhance current role responsibilities
- Participate in transformational school visits within the state of Massachusetts and across the country
